## The Adult Training Process

Step 1 - With your Training Adviser workout which Adult Training Modules are required for your role in Scouting. List modules on your Personal Learning plan. [Electronic link to a personal learning plan](#)

Step 2 – With your Training Adviser, using the Adult Personal File, see if you can demonstrate that you already have the skills / knowledge covered in any of the modules, listed on your personal learning plan.

Step 3 – With your Training Adviser, decide how you are going to cover the learning required for each module on your personal learning plan. Course from this calendar, small group, video, CD Rom? [Electronic link to a copy of the Adults Personal File](#)

Step 4 – Record on your Personal learning plan the date when you are going to complete your chosen learning, for all the required modules.

Step 5 – After completing the learning for each module, agree a validation method for module with your Training Adviser.

Step 6 – Get the Validation for each module assessed by your Training Adviser and ensure the validation for each module is signed for on your Personal Learning plan.

Step 7 - Ensure your Personal Learning Plan is completely filled in and signed and ensure it is forwarded on to your Local Training Manager, so a Wood badge recommendation form can be sent off the Gilwell.
