

## 35th Gordano District Scout Orienteering Event

- Date **Saturday 28 January 2006**
- Time **Registration from 12.00 Starts from 12.15 to 13.30. Courses close at 15.00**
- Place **Ashton Court, Bristol**  
Grid Reference ST 543 720 (**Note this is not the Mansion House, see directions**)
- Directions The registration and start is close to the North West corner of Ashton Court near Redwood Lodge. Enter Ashton Court via the track off Longwood Lane (gr ST 536 715). Longwood Lane is reached from either the B3128 or B3129.
- Car parking Parking is along the track leading from Longwood Lane. Please park carefully not to inconvenience other users
- Courses The event is the same as last year and will be a 'score' course  
All controls, descriptions and points scored will be marked on the maps  
The aim is to visit as many controls as possible within a one-hour limit  
Controls may be visited in any order  
Some controls (the more distant or difficult ones) will be worth more points  
Points will be deducted for those back late  
The winners will be the persons/teams with the most points (after deducting penalties)  
**Those training for Ten Tors should run as individuals; otherwise pairs are welcome**
- Participants Cubs will be very welcome, but do try to restrict size of group to 4 Cubs plus 1 or 2 adults. Should you wish to be out for longer than an hour, please start early. Guides and Families are also welcome to enter.
- Equipment Long trousers are compulsory. A tracksuit or tracksters are ideal.  
A long sleeved shirt is recommended  
Rubber studded running shoes will help to stop you falling over, but ordinary trainers will do or boots if you are walking.  
**(Some of the paths can be very muddy. There are many brambles off the paths.)**  
Compass & Whistle  
Transparent map bag (or a strong see through polybag)  
Watch
- Weather Bring a cagoule and spare clothes to change into when you get back. The event will only be cancelled if roads are unfit to drive on.
- Cost 50p per participant (incl. Adults). 50p per map. One map per group  
Results Free by email; 25p by post for those outside Gordano & Axe Districts.
- Toilets There are no toilets at the event the nearest are at the Mansion
- Dogs Your dogs are welcome, but please ensure they are fully under control if you take them on your course. This is a public area popular with dog-walkers, cyclist and the horse riders. Please respect the rights of other people to be in the woods, especially when passing them in a hurry, and walk past horses.
- HELP We are always in need of help, setting up and helping at Registration, at the start and finish during the event and of course clearing up and collecting control flags. If you can help please get in contact. No prior experience necessary**
