**P.O.R.** Rule 9.37 (n, o) - Shooting (extract)

Firearms may only be taken on to Scout premises, camp sites, camps or on Scout projects or expeditions if **prior permission in writing has been obtained**, both from the Home District/County Commissioner and **from the person authorised to be in charge of the premises, camp site, camp, project or expedition**, and if adequate arrangements for the safeguarding of the firearms in a locked cupboard or similar safe place have been made. Permission may be given only if the firearms are being transported or are in transit under supervision for use as permitted.
