



Woodhouse Park Site Safety



Vehicles

In the interest of safety **ALL** cars must be parked in the car parks provided, **NOT** on any of the roads or access points on the site. **NO** vehicles are allowed on the fields to unload without the permission of the Warden. Vehicles must also observe the 10 mph speed limit.

Fires

Only altar fires are permitted to be used on the site and these **MUST** be returned to the altar fire compounds in a clean state. In special circumstances the Warden may give permission for a fire pit to be dug in specified places.

Wood and Wood Piles

Care needs to be taken when collecting wood from the woodpile. It is also recommended that stout shoes be worn when collecting wood. All unused timber must be returned to the woodpile at the end of your stay. **Standing timber may NOT be cut.**

Waste Disposal

No pits are allowed for waste disposal. A waste water system is available from the warden if required. It is expected that campers will recycle as much as possible (please see recycling bins) and dispose of the remainder of their rubbish in the Scout tradition of **BURN, BASH and BIN it.**

Toilets

If chemical toilets are used these may **ONLY** be emptied at the disposal point adjacent to the Training Centre.

Knives and Axes

All campers are reminded of the Scout Association Code of Conduct regarding their use.

General

All site users are expected to act in a safe and sensible manner:

- **Do not** walk through other users' sites.
- Use good food hygiene as there are wild animals in the area.
- Quiet time 2300 and 0630.

Risk Assessments

It is recommended that Group Leaders prepare a risk assessment covering their stay on the site and satisfy themselves that adequate safety procedures are followed at all times. **Leaders are reminded that *THEY* are responsible for their members at all times.**
