The Boathouse is located at Phoenix Wharf, Lower Guinea Street, Bristol, BS1 6TJ

History

Benjamin Perry was a warehouse keeper and was part of the Bristol City Council Docks committee.

His firm later run by his sons, worked in Bristol Docks until the mid 20th Century. Where their business shifted its focus to the docks in Avonmouth



The building is located on Phoenix Wharf, Lower Guinea Street, Bristol BS1 6TJ

In 1982 the building was restored by the local scouts and guides and has been used by those organisations ever since
