## What is a Jamboree?

Jamborees are events which bring together groups of Scouts.

The World Scout Jamboree (WSJ) is the biggest of these – it's a global gathering of Scouts and Guides from every corner of the world that happens every 4 years.

It's a chance for young people to build international friendships, discover new cultures, and take part in an inspiring program of activities in a safe, inclusive, and sustainable environment.

# 26<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree

- Poland - being hosted within the borders of the city of Gdańsk
- Core Jamboree dates: 30<sup>th</sup> July – 8<sup>th</sup> August 2027
- *Interesting* journeys there and back either side of this
- Jamboree theme: *Bravely - aiming to inspire young people to act courageously for the future of humanity and the planet*

# The Cost

- Total cost per participant: £3750
  - UK Contingent fee: £2990
  - Unit 12 fee: £760
- UK Contingent fee includes the Jamboree fee, travel, insurance, contingent kit
- Unit 12 fee includes a 20-month training program, pre-/post-event travel activities, Unit extras (e.g. neckers)
- Avon have already paid £500 for every Unit member: **£3250** remaining per participant
